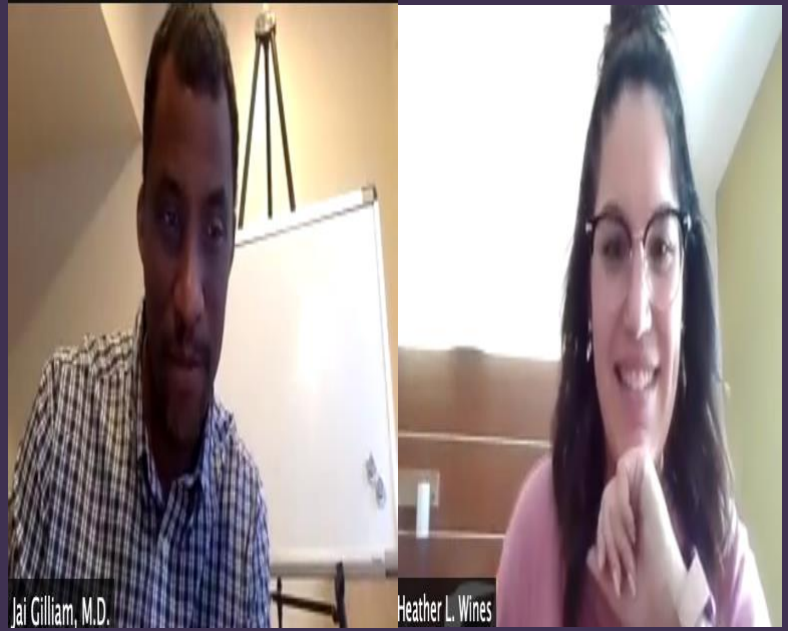


Prince William County Virginia | Pi Lambda Lambda
