

Prince William County Virginia | Pi Lambda Lambda (PLL) | Third District – On April 15, 2023. The Omega U Program visited VA Tech’s National Society of Black Engineers/Pre-College Initiative (NSBE/PCI) Program.

With more than 30,000 members, The National Society of Black Engineers is one of the largest student-managed organizations in the country. NSBE is comprised of more than 233 chapters on college and university campuses, 65 Alumni Extension chapters nationwide and 89 Pre-College chapters. These chapters are geographically divided into six regions. Virginia Tech’s NSBE chapter resides in Region 2, along with other eastern coast collegiate chapters.

The VT PCI Mentors divided students into teams to participate in the design challenge. Using Mechanical Engineering the students had to work together to design and build a device that can safely rescue a toy bear from a well from a height
